

**VILLAGE OF GERMANTOWN  
BOARD OF CANVASSERS  
Meeting Minutes  
November 10, 2014**

**CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order at 8:33 a.m. by Village Clerk Goeckner.

**PROCESS AND COUNT LATE-ARRIVING ABSENTEE BALLOTS – NOVEMBER 4, 2014 GENERAL ELECTION:**

**District 1, Wards 1, 8, 10, and 11:** There were three late arriving ballots received. Numbers from LA2677 and LA2678 were assigned; the names were marked as late arriving in the poll book. The following votes were counted and recorded on the tally sheet:
