**MEETING MINUTES
PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING
NOVEMBER 2, 2015
FIRE STATION 2**

CALL: The meeting was called to order at 5:34 p.m. by Chairman Hughes.

ROLL CALL: Chairman Hughes, Trustees Baum, Daniels and Myers.

Also present were Police Chief Hoell and Fire Chief Weiss.

PUBLIC COMMENT: no discussion.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: a motion was made by Baum, seconded by Daniels, to approve the minutes of the October 5, 2015 Public Safety Committee Meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT: Hoell reported on the following:

- Two Germantown officers participated in Operation Cross Country with the FBI which focuses on underage victims of sex trafficking
- Investigation into a strong arm robbery at Super 8
- Halloween Trick or Treat went smoothly with no problems
- Robert's fundraiser for the Honor Guard raised \$1200
- Three new officers were sworn in - P.O. Pierce, P.O. Rollinger & P.O. Pesch - and three more vacancies need to be filled
- Daniels questioned whether exit interviews are conducted, Hoell responded they are not done though it is something he would like to consider

FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT: Weiss reported on the following:

- No monthly report was completed for this meeting since there were 2 done last month, there will be a report done for next month's meeting

OVERTIME REPORTS FOR POLICE & FIRE DEPARTMENT: Hoell reported that the police department is showing an increase due to staffing shortages, and the overtime reports will continue to show that increase until the positions are filled and new officers have completed Field Training.

Weiss reported that the overtime costs have been reduced by \$47,000 and they continue to look into ways to keep overtime costs down.

POLICY UPDATES: Police Department - Hoell advised the police department had none.

Fire Department - Weiss advised the fire department had none.

REQUEST TO AMEND VILLAGE OF GERMANTOWN DESIGN, DRAFTING & CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS SECTION 6.0: Weiss advised that the department was requesting this amendment to require Harrington Integral Hydrant Storz nozzles or an equivalent on fire hydrants situated within the Village limits. He stated this would allow the fire department's engine company to attach directly to the 5" connection on fire hydrants without having to use an adaptor. Weiss added that Storz connectors are used by all surrounding fire departments.

A motion was made by Baum, seconded by Myers, to approve this request to amend Village of Germantown Design, Drafting & Construction Standards and Specifications Section, to require Harrington Integral Hydrant Storz nozzles or an equivalent on fire hydrants situated within the Village limits. Motion carried unanimously. Weiss added that this item would be going before the Plan Commission on November 9th.

REPLACEMENT FOR OFFICER VACANCY #1 - POLICE DEPARTMENT: Hoell advised the department was requesting to fill an officer vacancy created by the resignation of Officer Wick.

A motion was made by Daniels, seconded by Baum, to forward this request to fill the vacant officer position to Village Board with a recommendation of approval. Motion carried unanimously.

REPLACEMENT FOR OFFICER VACANCY #2 - POLICE DEPARTMENT: Hoell advised the department was requesting to fill an officer vacancy created by the resignation of Officer Schleis.

A motion was made by Baum, seconded by Myers, to forward this request to fill the vacant officer position to Village Board with a recommendation of approval. Motion carried unanimously.

NEXT MEETING: Hughes advised that next month's meeting would be held on Monday, December 7, 2015, 5:30 p.m. at Village Hall Boardroom.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:52 p.m.

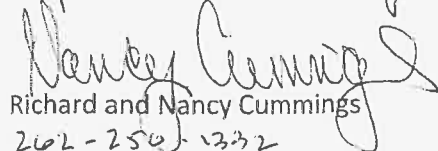
I would like to record my objection to the automatic renewal of the license at this location.

There are four major issues that I would like the councils to be aware of prior to acting on the
Renewal request

- 1.) Quality of life for surrounding neighbors. It is impossible to enjoy the peace and quiet of the Germantown area. With the number of dogs in the pens adjacent to the property line, it is impossible to sit on our patio and enjoy a conversation. As soon as we come outdoors the animals sense our presence and begin to bark to the extent that conversation is impossible.
- 2.) Cruel treatment of the animals. The dogs are not trained not to bark, but they are punished when they do. In the days around the receiving of this letter from the Village, there were three separate instances where the dogs were sprayed with water from a sprinkler system inside the pen. This does silence them for 30 – 60 seconds, but without associating the spray with the barking, instead of training the animals this is merely cruel treatment of the animals
- 3.) Animals not being contained. Among the animals the owners of the property have is a large white dog whose name I believe is Belle. On at least half a dozen occasions over this past summer the dog has been allowed to run loose. On these occasions the dog has come onto our property when we were outside and forced us indoors to protect our Cats who we make a practice of sitting on the patio with.
- 4.) Property damage from waste runoff. The current location of the holding pens is in violation of the fancier license requirement of a 15 ft. set back from the property line. Because of the non-conforming location. The waste from the cleaning of the pens washes onto our property. We have no direct proof this waste run off is damaging our trees on the lot line but are very concerned. We question why the license was granted in the first place. We were told that a representative from the village inspected the property when the last license was approved. How as the license granted without a proper setback?

Please consider these point when you review this license application. We would appreciate being advised if there is to be a public meeting to discuss this renewal.
