

**VILLAGE OF GERMANTOWN
BOARD OF CANVASSERS
MEETING MINUTES
FEBRUARY 22, 2016**

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 8:35 a.m. by Village Clerk Goeckner.

ROLL CALL: Members Lynn Grgich, Kathleen Sitzberger and Village Clerk Barbara Goeckner. Also present Observers Dahan Zoulek, Jeffrey M. Gonyo, Dave Schornack and Deputy Clerks Jilline Dobratz and Timmerly Tamborino.

PROCESS AND COUNT LATE-ARRIVING ABSENTEE BALLOTS: The Board of Canvassers processed the late-arriving absentee ballots received for the Spring Primary Election held on February 16, 2016 in the Village of Germantown.

District 1, Wards 1, 8, 10, and 11: There were two late-arriving absentee ballots received. Number LA5608 was assigned, recorded on the absentee log and the names were marked as late arriving in the poll book. The following votes were counted and recorded on the tally sheet:

Joanne F. Kloppenburg received 0 votes
Joe Donald received 0 votes

One ballot was rejected. Incident #1 was recorded on the log as the voter signature and witness signatures were missing on the certificate envelope. The envelope was also postmarked late, after Election Day, February 17, 2016. The ballot was placed in the rejected envelope.

The ballot was sealed in a ballot bag with seal number 0006761 and signed by Board of Canvass members. The certification Statement of Municipal Board of Canvass was completed and signed by the Board of Canvass members.

District 2, Wards 2, 5, 6 and 7: There was one late-arriving absentee ballot received. Number from LA517 was assigned, recorded on the absentee log and the name was marked as late arriving in the poll book. The following votes were counted and recorded on the tally sheet:

Joanne F. Kloppenburg received 0 votes
Joe Donald received 0 votes

There were no ballots rejected and no incidents recorded. The ballot was sealed in a ballot bag with seal number 0006762 and signed by Board of Canvass members. The certification Statement of Municipal Board of Canvass was completed and signed by the Board of Canvass members.

District 3, Wards 3, 4, 9, 16 and 17: There were two late-arriving absentee ballots received. Numbers from LA642 and LA643 were assigned, recorded on the absentee log and the names were marked as late arriving in the poll book. The following votes were counted and recorded on the tally sheet:

The ballots were sealed in a ballot bag with seal number 0006763 and signed by Board of Canvass members. The certification Statement of Municipal Board of Canvass was completed and signed by the Board of Canvass members.

District 4, Wards 12, 13, 14 and 15: There were three late-arriving absentee ballots received. Numbers from LA671 and LA672 were assigned, recorded on the absentee log and the names were marked as late arriving in the poll book. The following votes were counted and recorded on the tally sheet:

Joanne F. Kloppenburg received 0 votes

Joe Donald received 0 votes

Rock R. Brandner received 0 votes

Dennis Myers received 0 votes

Dahan Zoulek received 1 vote

Dale Peterson received 0 votes

An incident was recorded as the witness address was missing on the certificate envelope. One ballot was rejected. Incident #1 was recorded on the log as postmarked late, after Election Day, February 17, 2016. The ballot was placed in the rejected envelope.
