PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING
MAY 4, 2020
VIRTUAL WEBEX MEETING

CALL: The meeting was called to order at 6:01 p.m. by Chairman Hughes.

ROLL CALL: Chairman Hughes, Trustee Myers, Trustee Pieper and Trustee Wing.

Also present were Police Chief Snow, Fire Chief Delain, Clerk Braunschweig, Administrator Kreklow, Trustee Zabel.

PUBLIC COMMENT: no discussion

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: a motion was made by Myers, seconded by Wing, to approve the minutes of the April 6, 2020 Public Safety Committee meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT: Snow reported on the following:

- Thefts are up from 2019
- Family Trouble reports are slightly increased
- Domestic reports are down
- Regarding COVID-19, the goal of the police department is to gain voluntary compliance and so far no citations have been issued for violating the shut down order
- Phone calls have been received from business owners and residents who had questions on what was allowed
- 2 new officers will finish the academy this week, both are doing very well and will begin the Field Training Program next week
- Myers expressed his appreciation for the sign board placed at the recycling center
- Wing mentioned the current policy for bars/restaurants and if they are open for carryout orders, he questioned whether any warnings have been issued, Snow responded the department is not randomly checking establishments for compliance, but do respond if there is a complaint or concern called in
- Pieper asked if there was any information regarding swimming pools and if they would be allowed to open, Snow advised he had heard nothing specific to pools but could check with WEDC for updated information

FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT: Delain reported on the following:

- Their calls for service numbers are similar to last year's
- Requests have been received for department drive-bys for birthday parties, they are now restricting those responses for children 10 and under
- Ladder truck is still having issues, just repaired hydraulics for the cab tilt
- Discussions have been held with Rim's Edge Orchard regarding a possible house burn training

- Myers asked if there was information regarding businesses which would be opening, Delain stated there were some which were looking at opening
- Miller asked about the new ambulance, Delain advised it was ordered in February, specs were done last week and it would likely be July or August before finished
- Delain noted they currently have an ambulance dedicated to transfers/care of COVID-19 related calls in order to avoid any cross-contamination
- Zabel questioned the latest numbers for COVID-19 cases, Delain advised there were 22 cases and 4 deaths in Germantown, he added the information they currently receive only indicates the address of confirmed cases
- Pieper questioned whether the address locations are in clusters or spread out, Delain advised there were clusters around Virginia Highlands, Gables, remainder were spread out

OVERTIME REPORTS:

Police Department – Snow advised the overtime numbers are tracking well but will likely show an increase later when the numbers from being two officers short come through. It is anticipated that the new officers should be added to regular staffing by early fall.

Fire Department – Delain advised that they also were working short staffed due to a retirement but have since filled that position as of May 2nd and should be back to full staff moving forward.

Information: The American Legion Post #1 Submitted the attached request to waive the Liquor Licensing Fee. Since the reading of the request at the May 18, Village Board Meeting, the fees for the American Legion were paid anonymously.

The Liquor License Fees are as below:

Class A Beer	\$100 (No state maximum or minimum)
Class A Liquor	\$500 (\$500 state maximum. \$50 state minimum)
Class B Beer	\$100 (\$100 state maximum. \$0 state minimum)
Class B Liquor	\$500 (\$500 state maximum. \$50 state minimum)

The Village Budgets \$22,500 for Liquor / Beer Licenses. As of May 27, 2020, \$12,970 had been receipted in for Liquor / Beer Licenses. Premises have until 15 days prior to issuance to pay this fee. Six premises have not turned in their applications. Last year over \$25,000 was collected in this line item.

Amusement Arcade License \$ 100.00
Amusement Device Charge For 1 to 7 Devices \$ 25.00
Amusement Device Charge For 8 to 15 Devices \$ 30.00
Amusement Device Charge For 16 to 25 Devices \$ 35.00
Amusement Device Charge For More Than 25 Devices (also requires a CUP) \$ 40.00

The Village Budgets \$4,000 for Vending Machines. As of May 27, 2020, \$1,585 had been receipted in for Amusement Vending Machines. Last year \$3,915 was collected in this line item.

From past files, the Class B Liquor increased from \$425 to \$500 in 1993. The Class B Beer increased from \$75 to \$100 in 1984.

Thank you for bringing this to my attention

I asked the Village Administrator and the Highway department if Village Staff were made aware of silo deliveries for Gehl Foods occurring from Park Avenue, a no trucking street within Germantown

The response I received as as follows:

From Gehl Foods to Gtown Highway dept - May 6th

Jay,

I was wondering what the procedure is to close a few parking stalls on Park Ave. This would be Wednesday 7am thru Friday at 11am. We have some large tanks being delivered and their best path is to come down Park from 145 and then back into our parking lot, across Precincts parking lot, across Church and into our project site. With the turning radius of the trucks, they will need to swing their front end over and through these parking spots to straighten out their load.

The spots are the angle parking stalls on the west side of Park that start at the corner of Main Street and continue north. There are nine total stalls. Feel free to call and discuss or point me in the right direction.

From Engineer on Gtown highway dept to Gehl Foods - May 7th

That's good you were able to work things out with Bubs but Park Avenue is not an acceptable route for trucking. The street is marked for "No Trucking". Starting this morning and for tomorrow, we ask that you use an approved route. Such as having the trucks use Mequon Road to Pilgrim Road to Main Street.

Also, moving forward we ask for a minimum 48 hour notice before requesting the closure of parking stalls or driving trucks down a street marked no trucking. If you have any questions please let me know.
