

MEETING MINUTES
PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING

CALL: The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairman Myers.

Also present via WebEx were Police Chief Snow and Fire Chief Delain. Clerk Braunschweig was present.

PUBLIC COMMENT: no comments

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: a motion was made by Hudson, seconded by Pieper, to approve the minutes of the April 4, 2022 Regular Meeting and the April 18, 2022 Special Meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT: Snow reported on the following:

- Open officer position has been offered to Justin Clemens who will be starting on May 12th
- Officer Jeremy Peterson will finish at the academy next week and will begin his Field Training
- Will be meeting with the Police & Fire Commission to discuss lateral transfers for officers
- Officer Justin Pesch assisted with a baby delivery at a residence
- Police Memorial Bagpipe Service will be held at Slinger Police Department on May 13th at 11:30 p.m., Snow will forward a memo to Village Hall with the information
- Hudson questioned the increase in narcotics cases (over 80%) and DOA's (400%), Snow advised the department had participated in a drug interdiction, which was coordinated by Lt. Mikulec, which increased the numbers for narcotics cases, and the rise in DOA's was reflected by the low numbers on record where an increase from 1 to 5 will show as significant.
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FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT: Delain reported on the following:

- Their department continues to be very busy, they have received 810 calls for the year
- They are moving forward with the hiring process, there are two open positions, they have received six applications so far – applications close on May 13th
- The department responded to a fire call at Sendik's yesterday morning
- Inspections continue to be completed and are going well
