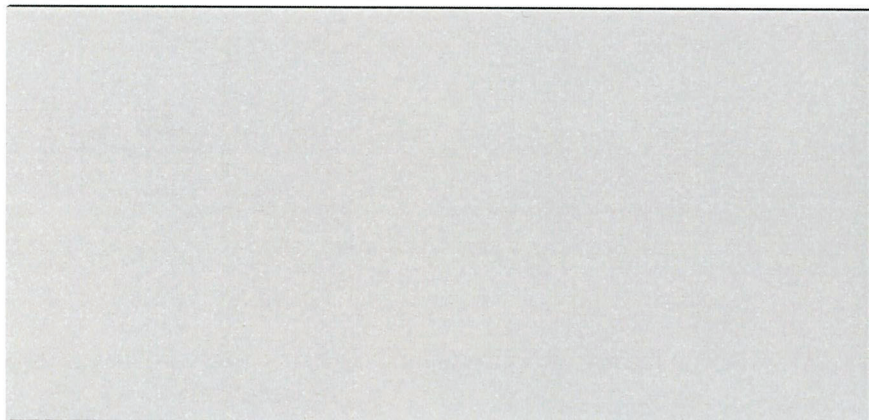

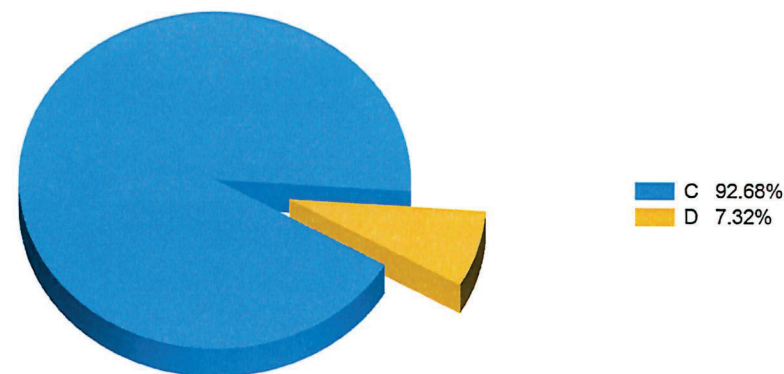

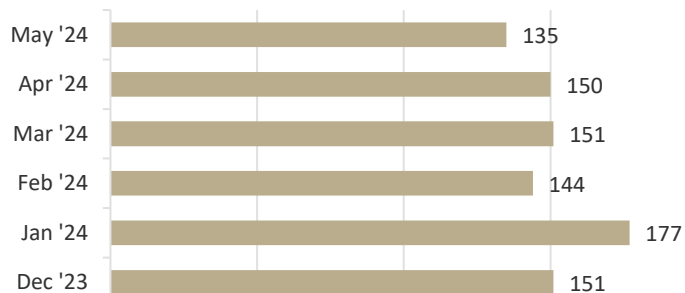

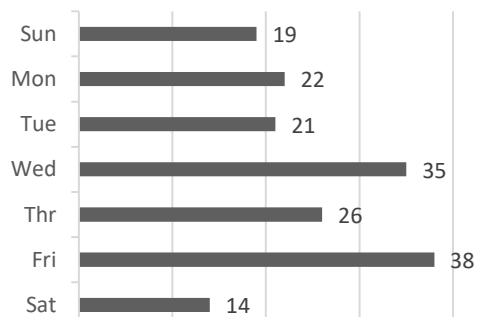
## MAY EMS Calls = 135 (non-MVA)



## MAY - Calls by Time of Day

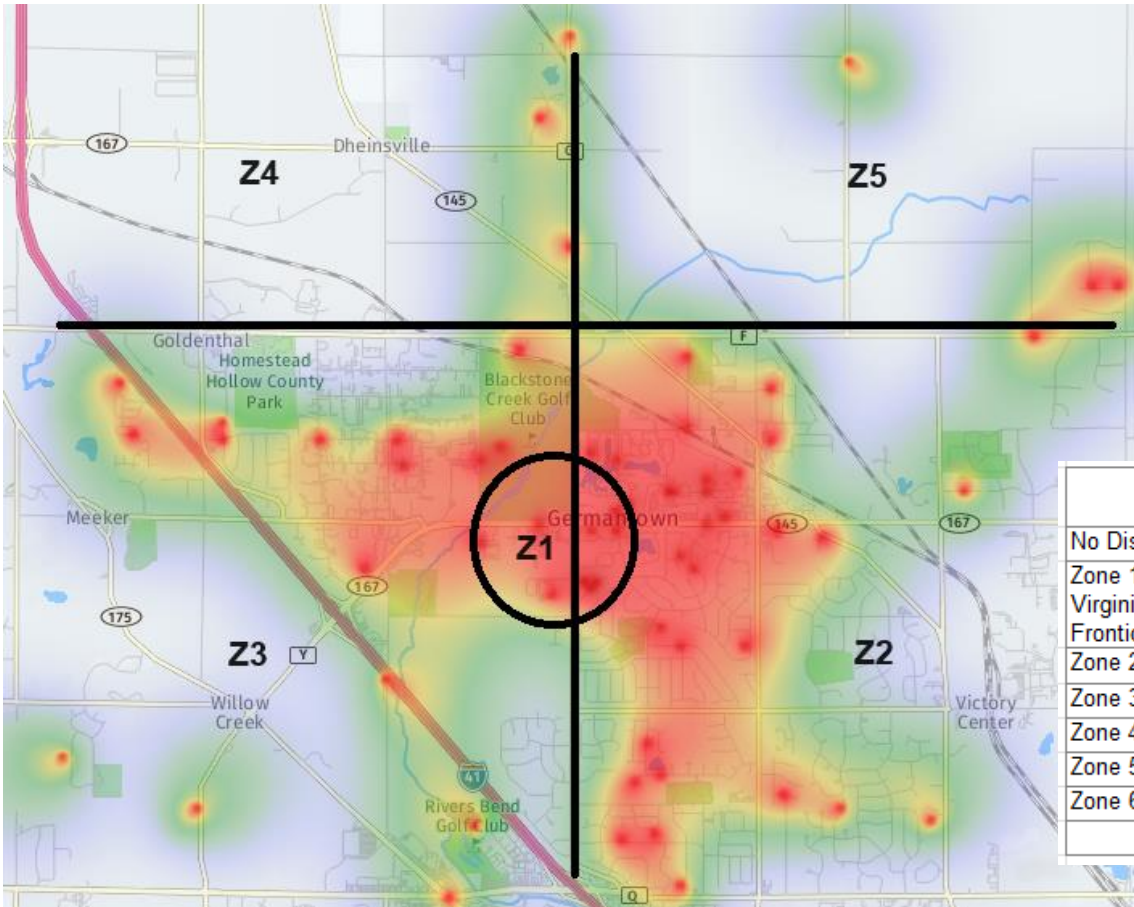

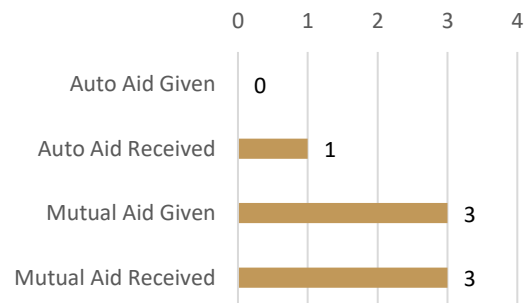

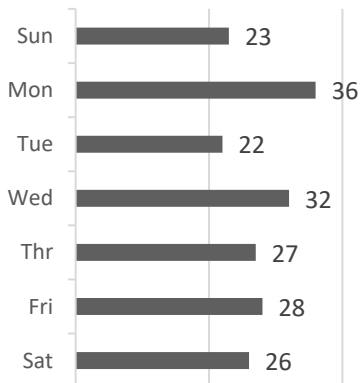

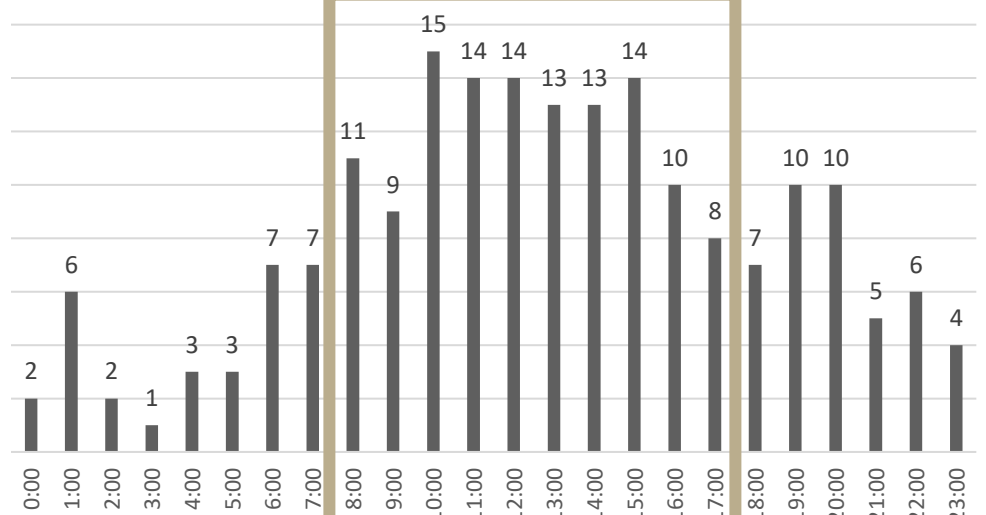

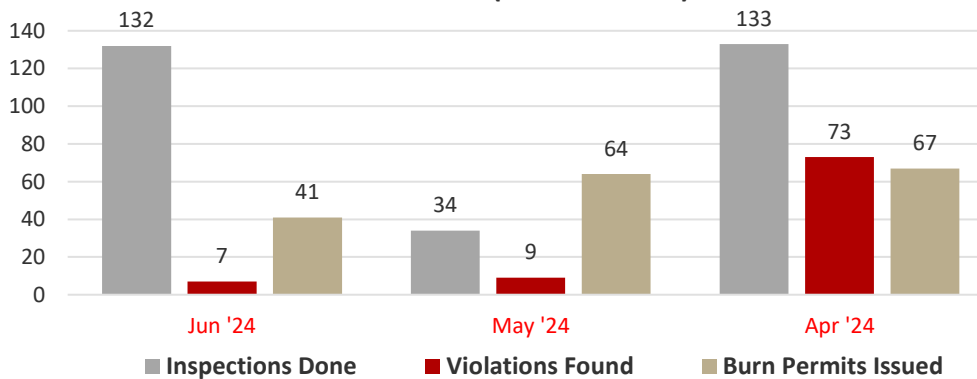
